

3 November 2011: Christoph Gaertner Zeppelin- and Airmail Auction

It is the first Christoph Gaertner specialized zeppelin and airmail auction presented in a separate catalogue featuring almost 2.000 lots with fine zeppelin mails and airmails. This includes catapult mail North- and South Atlantic, DO-X, worldwide airmails, zeppelin pioneer mail, Rhein-Main Airmails, zeppelin mail of the airships LZ-127 and LZ-129 and of course a large number of treaty states and other transmitted mail from all over the world. Remarkable are four LZ-129 "Hindenburg" crash covers.
